The Southwest Wisconsin High Protein Show will be on June 19, 2021. There will be two judges at the show, splitting the breeds between the judges. In the showmanship classes, Jersey, Guernsey, Ayrshire, Milking Shorthorn and Brown Swiss entries will be combined. Showmanship will be the first classes judged. Animals are to be checked in on show day by 8:30am.

There will be a potluck on Saturday during the show, if you would like to participate bring a dish to pass and your own tableware. There will also be a potluck on Friday night with the show providing the meat for Friday night.

RULES

- 1. Entry fee of \$5.00 per head will be charged if entries are postmarked by June 1st. Late entries will be \$20.00 per head. Entry fees will be used toward show expenses. Make checks payable to Parish 3 Jersey Breeders.
- **2.** Health Rules and Regulations/Dairy Cattle:
 - There are no test or health document requirements for Wisconsin cattle. However, fair management is responsible for maintaining records of persons who have exhibited at the show and the identification of animals shown for 5 years. Acceptable forms of animal identification for breeding animals are (1) an official metal eartag, (2) a breed registration number, (3) a breed registration tattoo or (4) other identification approved by the department. Entry blanks submitted and signed by exhibitors, including one of the forms of identification listed above, will fulfill the exhibitor requirements. The fair's records of animals shown and exhibited are to be retained in case these are needed for disease tracing purposes. Out of state exhibitors need a vet inspection form, please bring two copies of the form to the show.
- 3. Junior exhibited cattle will be judged in competition with open class cattle. Junior Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Milking Shorthorn and Jersey exhibitors will receive additional recognition. To receive junior recognition youth must be at least 8 years old and at the halter of the animal. To be eligible for Junior awards at the SW Protein Show the exhibitor must live in the Parish 3 area, including counties lowa, Grant, Lafayette, Richland, Crawford and Sauk. The animal must be shown by the junior owner, if a junior has more than one animal in a class, the other animal must be led by a junior younger than the owner. Juniors can be no older than 20 years of age on January 1, 2021
- **4.** Ayrshire junior animals may be owned solely by the junior exhibitor or in a partnership provided the junior exhibitor's name appears on the registration paper, also Ayrshire Breeders' Association lease agreement will be accepted.
- 5. Brown Swiss ownership: For an animal to be exhibited as Junior owned, in all classes, the recorded ownership must show in the sole ownership of the exhibitor or a partnership comprised of Brown Swiss Association Junior members. (Adult-Junior partnerships and family partnerships are not acceptable.) Animals that are leased through the National Brown Swiss Association Lease Program are also eligible to be shown as juniors.
- **6.** For Guernsey Junior Exhibitor the recorded ownership must show in the sole ownership of the exhibitor or partnership comprised of only AGA Junior Members or a participant in the American Guernsey Association Youth Lease Agreement Program.
- 7. Milking Shorthorn junior ownership of the animal must be recorded in the AMSS herdbook in the name of the Junior exhibitor(s). Animals may be owned in partnerships, animals that are leased through the American Milking Shorthorn Junior Society Lease Program are also eligible to be shown by juniors.
- **8.** For animals to be in the Junior Jersey Show, we are following the AJCA ownership rules. The exhibitor must be listed as Recorded Owner on the registration certificate, either (1) as the sole owner or (2) by his/her name in joint ownership.
- Be sure all leased paperwork is complete before coming to the show, if not complete will not be eligible for Junior Show
- **10.** Production awards as sponsored by individual breed association will be presented. In order to be eligible, Official DHIA or DHIR production sheets must accompany the entry of the animal.
- 11. Exhibitors must provide their own bedding and feed for cattle. At the end of the show exhibitors will need to pull bedding to the center aisle from front of stalls to ease in cleaning of barns.
- 12. Exhibitors are allowed to come in the day before the show, not before 12pm on Friday June 18.
- **13.** Cows will start approximately at 1pm.
- **14.** Remember to bring registration papers to the show or an emailed registration verification from the breed organization. Papers will be checked at show.
- **15.** All showmanship animals need to entered in the show.
- **16.** Calves need to be at least two months of age on the day of the show.
- 17. We will be using the Farm Progress and Lands' End Dairy Lane barns for the show, if you tie in one of the other barns a cash fine will be accessed and would need to be paid before the beginning of the show.
